⇒ **Hawkes Bay Executive Golf Course**

A Message From...

The Districts will be adopting their FY16-17 Final Budgets and maintenance assessments rates at their September Board meetings. Florida State Statutes require that a Final Budget and Final Maintenance Assessments be approved no later than September 15th of each year.

Please note: There are no proposed increases to maintenance assessments for FY16-17!!! The final assessment approved at the September meetings cannot be higher than the proposed maintenance assessments.

You probably have received your TRIM BILL (proposed tax bill) notice within the last week or two. Your maintenance assessment amount will be located under the non-ad valorem section of the notice. It will be the same amount as the amount that you paid last year. Districts 10 and 11 rates will reflect a slight decrease due minor acreage adjustments due to platting. The maintenance assessment is only paid once a year with your tax bill and pays for the operation and maintenance of your District. These funds are necessary to maintain the existing level of service and ensure the long-term integrity of the infrastructure necessary for the sustainability of their Districts.

During the September Board meetings, the District Board of Supervisors will conduct public hearings to accept public input and then adopt the Final FY16-17 Budget and maintenance assessment rates. The public hearing will take place during the District Board meetings as listed below:
