Village Community Development District No. 11 Landowner Election

A Landowner Election will be held to elect three (3) Supervisors to the Village Community Development District (VCDD) No. 11 Board of Supervisors on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the Moyer Recreation Center, 3000 Moyer Loop, The Villages, Florida. The three individuals who have been nominated are Scott Renick, Patty Hoxie and Dan Sprung. Because this is a Landowner Election each parcel or property shall be entitled to one vote per acre. The two seats receiving the highest number of votes will receive a four (4) year term and the remaining candidate will be elected to a two (2) year term.

What to bring

- Automotive fluids
- Automotive batteries
- Cleaners
- Fertilizers
- Fluorescent lamps and Mercury containing devices
- Fungicides
- Wood preservatives
- Herbicides
- Rechargeable household batteries
- Household electronics (TVs, VCRs, computers, etc.)
- Latex & oil based paints
- Paint removers
- Paint thinners
- Pesticides
- Pool chemicals
- Solvents
- Smoke detectors
- Propane tanks (25lbs)



What not to bring

- Biological/Infectious waste
- Explosives
- Radioactive waste
- Empty paint cans

HOW TO PACKAGE AND TRANSPORT CHEMICALS

- (1) Do NOT mix chemicals together.
- (2) Keep products in original labeled containers if possible.
- (3) Place containers into cardboard boxes to prevent breakage.
- (4) Place leaky container in clear plastic bag and transport in box with newspaper.
- (5) Put boxes in trunk or in back of vehicle away from passengers.
