The following facilities will be closed or have scheduled maintenance:

⇒ **Softball Complexes**

All softball complexes will be closed for general maintenance including roto-tilling, laser leveling, adding turf-ace and new batter boxes until Sunday, December 24th.

⇒ **Paradise Archery Range**

The Paradise Archery Range will be closed for fence replacement Thursday, December 21st and Friday, December 22nd.

⇒ **Saddlebrook Recreation Center**

The indoor bathrooms at the Saddlebrook Recreation Center will be closed for maintenance Saturday, December 23rd to January 2nd. The pool bathrooms and billiards room bathroom will be available for usage.

⇒ **Colony Cottage Recreation Center**

The Colony Cottage Regional Recreation Center and Sports Pool will be closed on Saturday, December 30th for quarterly maintenance.

Multi-Modal Path Reconstruction Project

The reconstruction project of the Hacienda Trail and other Multi-Modal Paths north of C.R. 466 began on Tuesday, June 27, 2017 and is anticipated to be complete in February 2018. This project encompasses existing concrete multi-modal paths north of C.R. 466 in the geographical areas of Village Community Development District No. 1 and the Lady Lake portion of The Villages.

- The portion of the path along the Hacienda Hills Championship Golf Course to Soledad Way is complete and open for use.
- The contractors are currently asphaltting the path from Panama Place to Rio Grande Avenue, the portion from Hacienda Hills Championship Golf Course to Del Mar Drive as well as from Del Mar Drive to Chula Vista.

• The project is anticipated to be substantially complete by January 5th, with the exception of the reconstruction of the path on El Camino which is anticipated to be complete on February 3rd.

Not only do the gates throughout the community serve as a traffic control device, they also serve as an important safety feature.

The entry and exit lanes at the gates houses have cameras installed that are monitored 24/7/365 by the Gate Operations division of Community Watch. Their primary responsibilities are to remotely monitor all live video feeds from gate cameras to ensure efficient gate operations and to allow remote access through the gates for our residents and visitors.

There are over 80 gate houses in the community with well over 400 cameras. The community is effectively monitored and the District government maintains a positive working relationship with the local law enforcement agencies to provide for the well-being and safety of the residents.

Please have your bags out no later than 6:00 a.m. All others will follow your normal collection schedule.

If your sanitation collection is serviced by Waste Management in the Village of Fenney, you will not have sanitation collection service on Monday, December 25th or Monday, January 1st. Collection will occur on your next normally scheduled collection day.
