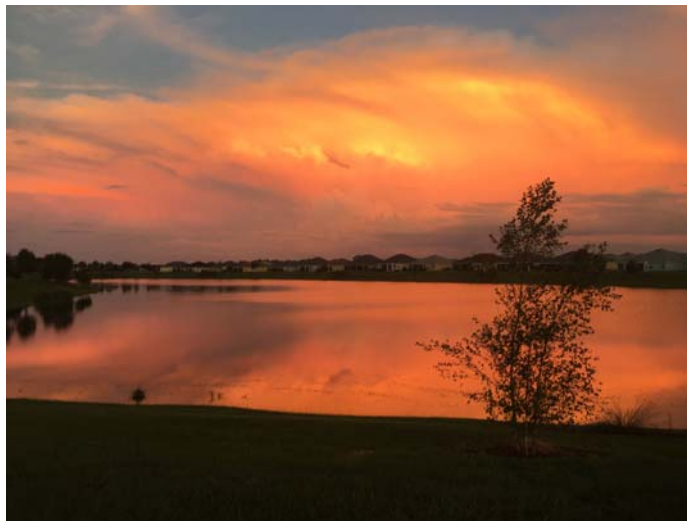

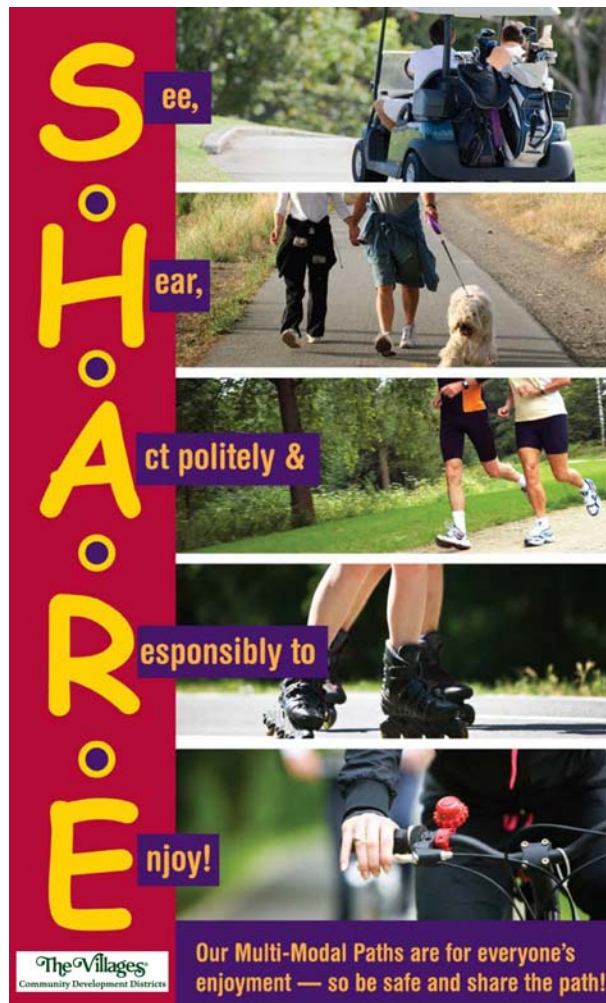
Do you understand the source of your irrigation water?
