The following areas will be closed or have scheduled maintenance:

⇒ **El Santiago Shuffleboard Courts**

The SeaBreeze Shuffleboard Courts will be closed for resurfacing and maintenance April 10th through April 15th.

⇒ **Sterling Heights Tennis Courts**

The Sterling Heights Tennis Courts are currently closed for maintenance.

⇒ **Canal Street Billiards Room**

The Canal Street Recreation Center's Warwick Room will be closed for billiard table resurfacing April 5th through April 7th.





El Santiago Storage Bins

This project is nearing completion! The storage bins will be located at the El Santiago Golf Course.



Saddlebrook IPM Building

The grading for the concrete floor and forming of the sump pits is now complete. The floor rough-in of the mechanical, plumbing and electrical systems are complete.



Saddlebrook Village Recreation Center Renovation

The interior finishes are underway. The new doors are being installed and the window installation is complete. The billiards room plumbing, mechanical and electrical rough-ins are nearing completion and the new roof is complete. The project is on schedule for an opening in June 2017. For your safety and the safety of all workers, please refrain from entering all construction areas.



What's Happening in Your District



The District Property Management Department is coordinating with Rainey Construction to mill and overlay the Villa roads in VCDD No. 5 and 6 that were not previously completed. The work began on January 16, 2017 and will continue through July 2017.

The District will deliver notices to each home that will be impacted by the work approximately 7-10 days in advance, in addition to placing informational signs at the entry and exit of each villa which will include the anticipated start and end date of the project.

The timeline may be adjusted due to unforeseen circumstances, including weather. If the timeline is adjusted, the informational signs at the villa entry and exits will be updated.

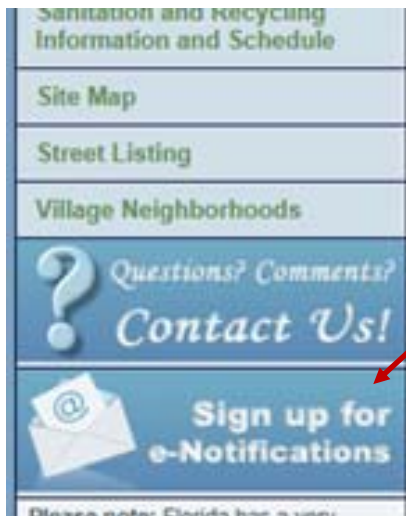

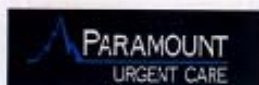

What to bring



- Automotive fluids
- Automotive batteries
- Cleaners
- Fertilizers
- Fluorescent lamps and Mercury containing devices
- Fungicides
- Wood preservatives
- Herbicides
- Rechargeable household batteries
- Household electronics (TVs, VCRs, computers, etc.)
- Latex & oil based paints
- Paint removers
- Paint thinners
- Pesticides
- Pool chemicals
- Solvents
- Smoke detectors
- Propane tanks (25lbs)



What not to bring

- Biological/Infectious waste
- Explosives
- Radioactive waste
- Empty paint cans

HOW TO PACKAGE AND TRANSPORT CHEMICALS

- (1) Do NOT mix chemicals together.
- (2) Keep products in original labeled containers if possible.
- (3) Place containers into cardboard boxes to prevent breakage.
- (4) Place leaky container in clear plastic bag and transport in box with newspaper.
- (5) Put boxes in trunk or in back of vehicle away from passengers.
