

## **RULES OF USE**

- Picnic pavilions are located at many Village Recreation Center locations.
- Picnic pavilion use is for Villages residents and their guest(s) with valid guest IDs and photo ID.
- A person, entity or organization requesting and receiving a facility permit for rental of a District facility shall have the sole responsibility to accommodate qualified individuals pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Requests are limited to 50 individuals maximum.
- When using barbecue grills, it is recommended that they be placed in the parking lot area with a protective mat underneath to minimize stains. If a grill is going to be used in the picnic/ recreation area, a protective mat must be placed underneath the grill at all times. Any damage to the facility will result in necessary charges for repairs.
- It is recommended that users bring their own chairs for use in addition to the available seating at the picnic tables.
- The Recreation & Parks Department will supply a limited amount of ice and three (3) banquet tables at the picnic pavilion excluding holidays when the Recreation Centers are closed (New Year's Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas).

Small picnic pavilions at neighborhood centers are excluded.

Rain rooms are based on availability and can be reserved for up to 4 hours. Rain rooms are not available on holidays.

- Delivered food items shall be limited to pizza, sandwich trays and other food items that do not require any on-site preparation or warming equipment.
- If the event is catered, all food items must be brought or delivered to the facilities fully prepared and ready to serve.
- BYOB is defined as alcoholic beverages for personal consumption and use. Individuals may not sell alcoholic beverages, nor may they be distributed at the event for group consumption. Kegs are prohibited as BYOB.
- Individuals using the picnic pavilion for an event are responsible for cleaning up after themselves. All trash is to be picked up, bagged and placed in the trash receptacles.
- The recreation assistants on duty are there to assist you with your event (excluding holidays).
