**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE DISTRICT #13
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT BUDGET
FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2024
AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2025 FOR
HURRICANE DEBRIS MONITORING AND
REMOVAL**

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2024, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Fiscal Year 2024-25 Budget; and,

WHEREAS, debris monitoring and removal services were procured in order to complete the removal of debris district-wide; and,

WHEREAS, on October 9, 2024, Hurricane Milton made landfall in Florida this resulted in approximately 711 cubic yards of debris that needed to be removed; and,

WHEREAS, the total expenses that are the responsibility of Village Community Development District Number 13 totaled \$33,259.53; and,

WHEREAS, the budget needs to be amended in the amount of \$33,260 to cover the cost of debris monitoring and removal within the District; and,

WHEREAS, the District has applied for FEMA Reimbursement for the total costs incurred for this storm event; and,

WHEREAS, the request to amend the Fiscal Year 2024-25 budget has been reviewed and approved by the District Manager.


