Ways To Get Involved

HOW CAN I GET INVOLVED?

There are many opportunities to get involved in The Villages! One of the great things about The Villages lifestyle is that there are thousands of groups organized by resident volunteers that appeal to many different interests, recreational activities, arts and crafts, and more!

WHAT IS A RESIDENT LIFESTYLE VOLUNTEER?

Resident lifestyle volunteers are the leaders of the activity groups that fill social, recreational, educational, emotional, or physical needs of members.

HOW CAN I START A RESIDENT LIFESTYLE GROUP?

To become a Resident Lifestyle Group, the resident interested in starting an activity/group must complete a Resident Survey Request Form and a Volunteer Application and submit both to the Recreation Department.

HELPFUL TIP

In order to participate in recreational activities, an activity release must be filled out. Make sure to complete a new form at the beginning of each calendar year.



WHAT CLUBS & ACTIVITIES ARE OFFERED?

DO I HAVE TO SIGN UP / REGISTER FOR ACTIVITIES?

All resident lifestyle volunteer groups are open to all residents of The Villages with a valid Resident ID card. We recommend you check with the prospective group about the group's expectations, membership requirements, dues and other fees, etc., prior to attending a club or activity.

Know Before You Go

Guest ID Cards

HOW CAN MY FAMILY AND FRIENDS JOIN THE FUN?

Residents of The Villages with an original valid Resident ID card may apply for a Guest ID card for their guest(s) to enjoy recreation amenities. A qualified guest is defined as an individual whose current residence is outside Lake, Marion and Sumter counties. A resident who has a son, daughter, grandchild or great grandchild (and their spouses) who reside in Lake, Marion or Sumter counties may apply for an In-Area Guest ID card.

Residents must provide all required guest information requested on the application in order to be issued a Guest ID card.

WHEN SHOULD GUESTS CARRY THEIR GUEST ID CARD AND DO RESIDENTS HAVE TO ACCOMPANY THEM?

- Guests are required to carry their original Guest ID card when using a District amenity facility even if accompanied by a resident.
- If the guest is under 19 years of age, they must be accompanied by a Villages resident, or a guest 19 years of age or older who must have a valid Guest ID card and photo ID.
- The accompanying resident is required to have an original Resident ID card. If a guest(s) does not have a valid Guest ID card with them, the guest(s) will be denied access to District amenity facilities.
- In-Area Guests, regardless of age, will be required to have the sponsoring resident in attendance with them at all times when using District amenity facilities.
- If the In-Area Guest(s) is not with the sponsoring resident they will be denied access to District amenity facilities.

HELPFUL TIP

Any resident requesting a Guest ID card(s) must submit their application either in person or online. It's easy to apply online! Visit DistrictGov.org > Services > Resident Services > ID Cards and click "Apply Online" under Guest Identification Cards. Please allow for a three-day processing time for all online requests.

In-Area Guest ID Applications cannot be submitted online and must be completed in person.



WHAT ARE THE AGE REQUIREMENTS FOR GUEST ID CARDS?

- All approved guests 1 year of age and older will be issued a Guest/In-Area Guest ID card.
- All approved guests 19 years of age and older must also have photo identification when using District amenity facilities.
- Some facilities have minimum age requirements.

WHAT FACILITIES ARE GUESTS PERMITTED TO USE?

- Please refer to DistrictGov.org > Recreation, Parks & Golf > Recreation > Recreation & Parks Publication "See the Schedule" button, or check The Villages Phone Book for guest approved facilities.
 - All approved facilities are also listed on the Guest ID/In-Area Guest ID card forms.
 - All guests are required to follow all District rules and regulations governing the use of District amenity facilities.
 - Residents and Guests are encouraged to check-in at a Recreation Center prior to using any recreation facility.

HOW LONG ARE GUEST IDS VALID?

- Guest ID cards are issued for a guest(s) whose current residence is outside Lake, Marion and Sumter counties for up to 30 days from the issue date.
- Guest ID card renewals may be requested after the 30th day for an additional 30 days and renewals may continue to be issued every 30 days.
- The In-Area Guest ID card for qualified family members is valid for one (1) year from date of issuance.

WHAT HAPPENS IF THERE IS INCLEMENT WEATHER?

In the event of inclement weather, the Recreation & Parks department recommends patrons at outdoor recreation areas find shelter and wait at least 30 minutes or longer prior to resuming safe, normal activities as deemed advisable by a Public Safety or National Weather Service Advisory.

The Recreation & Parks Department may close facilities and/or cancel/postpone or relocate activities at Recreation facilities for public safety in the event of any storm warnings issued by the National Weather Service, Public Safety, or the Recreation & Parks Department.

HOW WILL I KNOW IF THERE IS A WEATHER RELATED DELAY OR CANCELLATION?

Depending on the type of weather event and impact, staff will communicate via email, word of mouth, posting on the website, or other media sources regarding any cancellation/postponing information. Weather conditions and the type of facility may vary from center to center in The Villages community.

HELPFUL TIP

Here are some of the reasons for weather related cancellations:

- Outside temperature of 35 degrees or below
- Outside temperature heat index of 104 degrees or higher
- Rain, wind, lightning and/or severe conditions that compromise the safety of players or the condition of the facilities.

Recreation Centers


With a wide variety of unique recreation centers conveniently located throughout The Villages, exploring new and favorite activities is made easy and fun.

Pools

WHAT TYPE OF POOLS CAN BE FOUND IN THE VILLAGES?

There are three types of pools throughout The Villages community: Sports Pools, Adult Pools and Family Pools. Each pool type has different uses and purposes.

Sports Pools

These pools have specific schedules of activities: Lap swim, water walk, water exercise programs, water volleyball, etc. Be sure to check the sports pool activity schedule before you go.



7AM - Dusk Residents only 30+

Adult Pools

Intended for refreshing socialization & nonorganized/scheduled activities. Regularly scheduled water exercise groups are encouraged to use the sports pools.



7:30AM - Dusk For ALL residents & guests 30+

Family Pools

For residents who have family members visiting regardless of age. Noodles, unbreakable masks, goggles and small buckets are the only items allowed in these pools.

Parks 🏄 💝 🙀 🔣



Golf and Fishing

HOW CAN I PLAY GOLF IN THE VILLAGES?



As a Villager, you'll enjoy complimentary golf on all Executive, Pitch & Putt, and Putting courses with no greens fees. This, along with all the amazing recreation throughout The Villages, are all included within your low monthly amenity fee.

A trail pass is required for use of a golf car on the courses and may be paid per round, monthly,

semi-annually or annually. There is no trail fee applied to residents or guests walking on the executive courses. A greens fee is required for guests to play golf on the executive courses.

CANIFISHIN THE VILLAGES?

Yes! The Village Community Development Districts and the state's Water Management Districts oversee and manage many of the water bodies located throughout The Villages community. These water bodies serve several purposes for the community and also provide anglers fishable areas for their recreational enjoyment.
